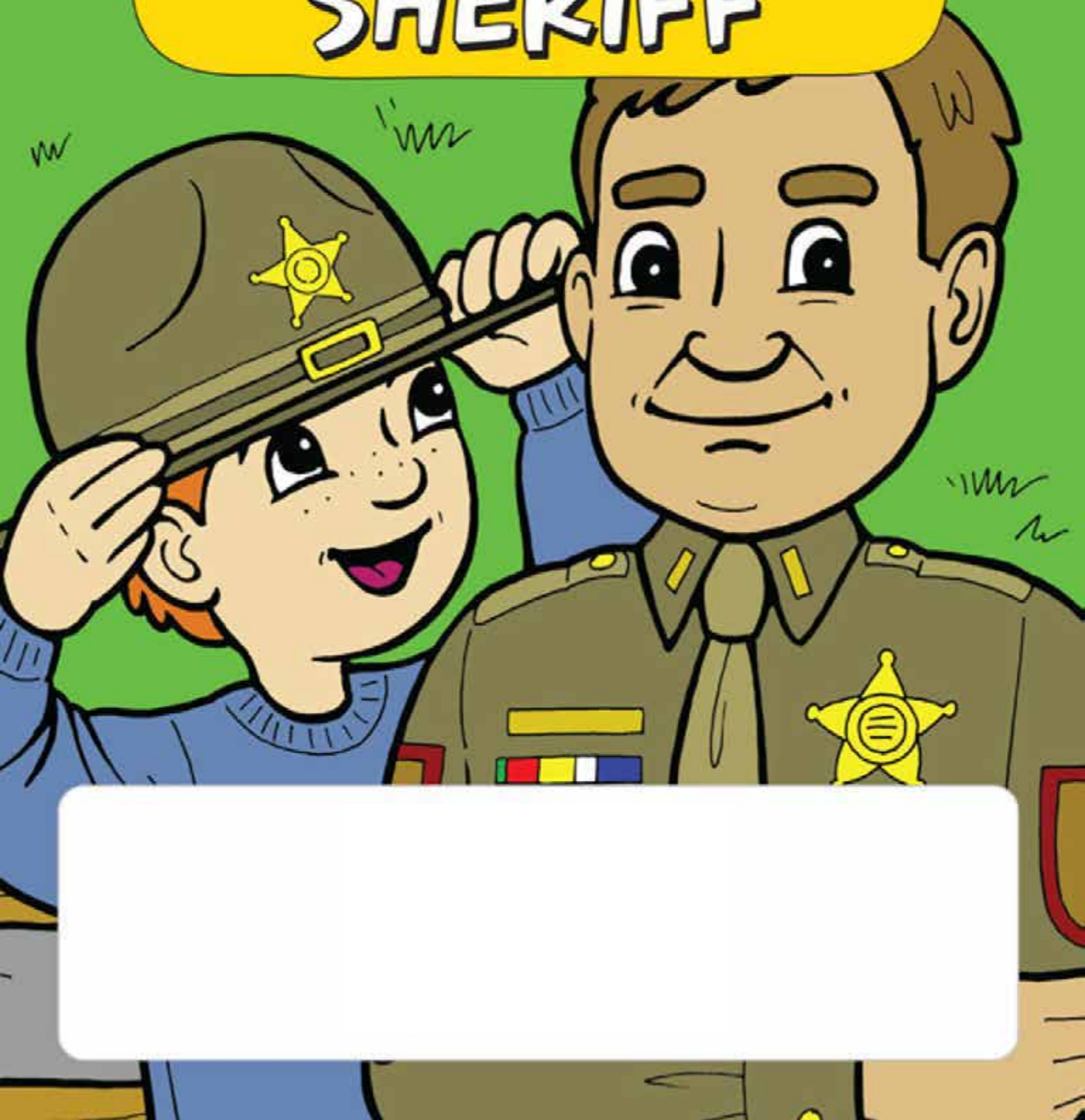

"You do have to be a grown-up to be a sheriff," he said with a smile.

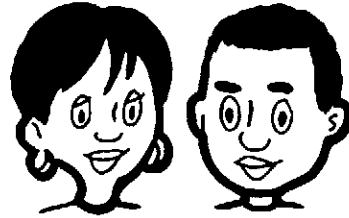


"But guess what...there's lots of things you can do to make you and your friends and your home and your neighborhood safe." "Like what?" I asked him.

- telephone number including area code

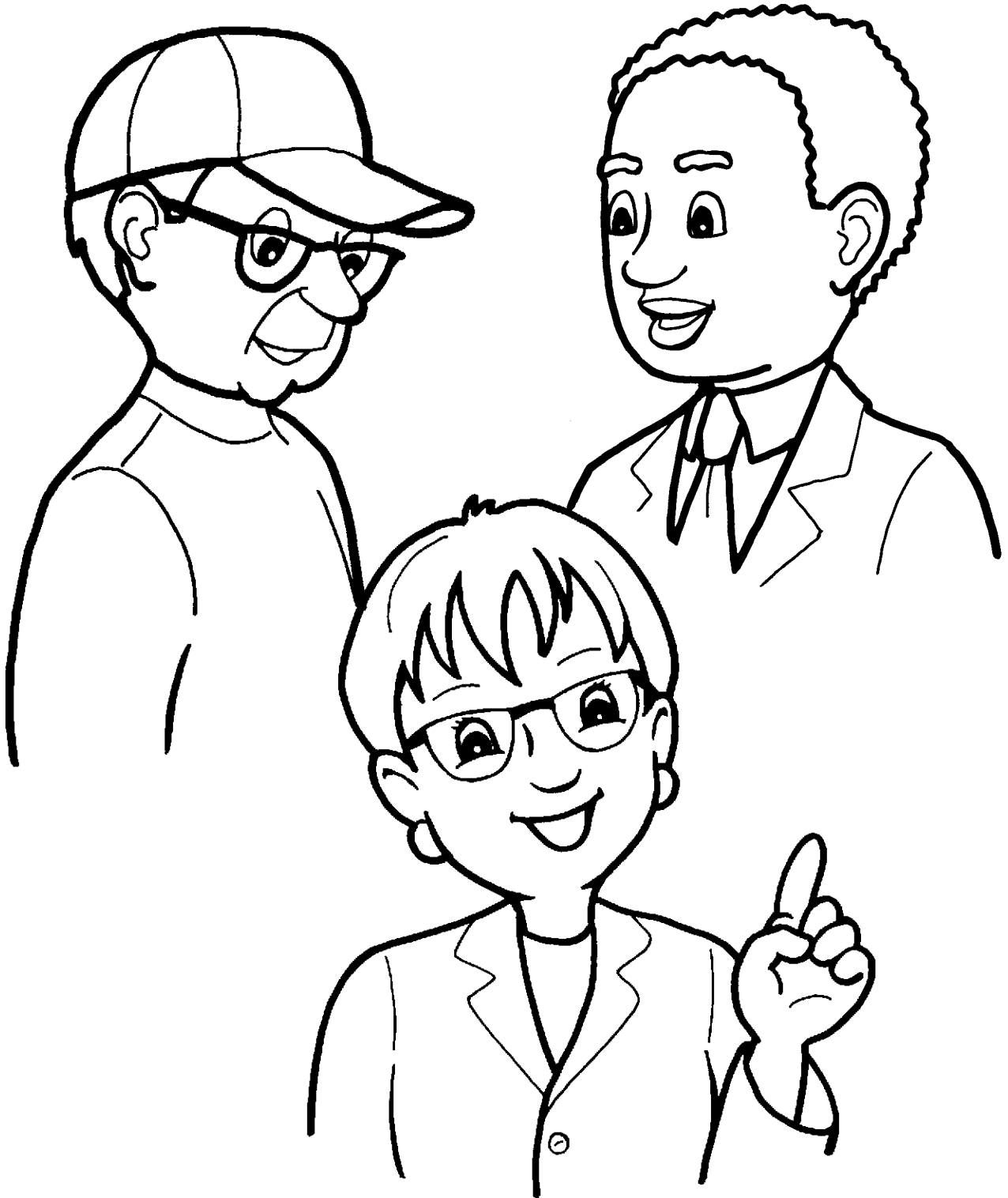


- family's first and last names

NO to drugs and alcohol.**

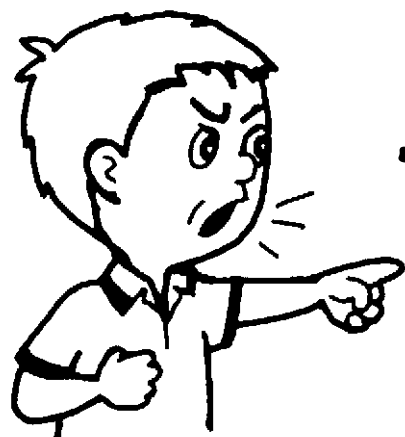


If you find a weapon or something dangerous, DON'T touch it.

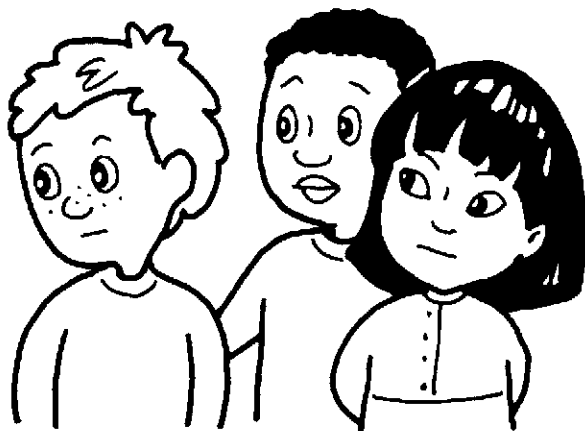


Get away and tell a grown-up you trust.

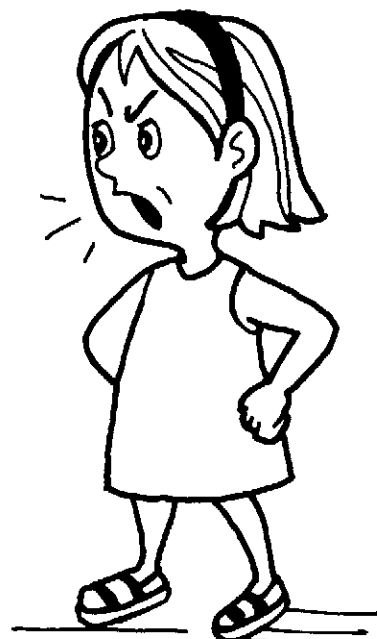
Here are some other things to keep us safe. If someone is bullying you:

- Ask an adult for help

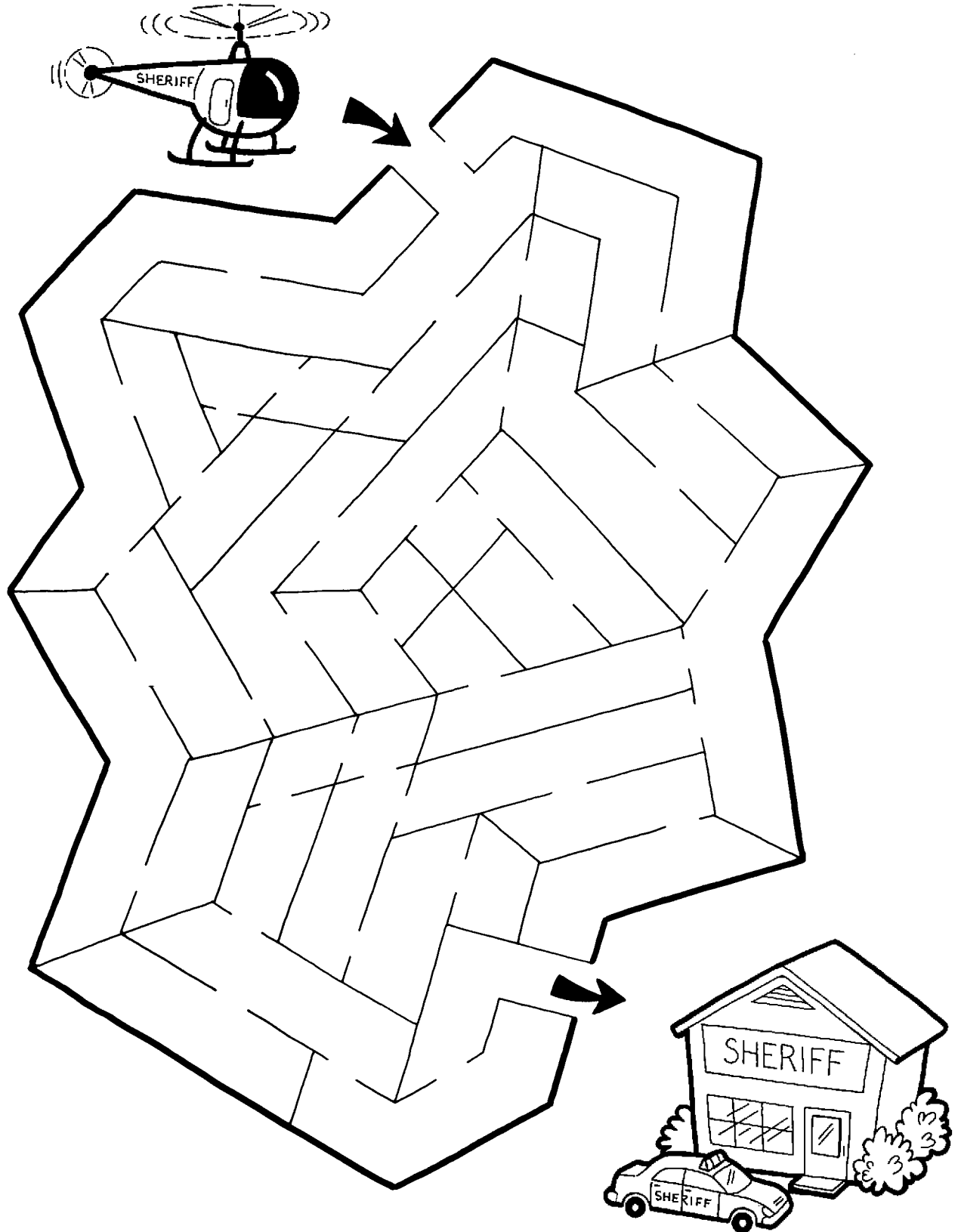
**“That’s a lot to remember,”
I told Sheriff Davis.**

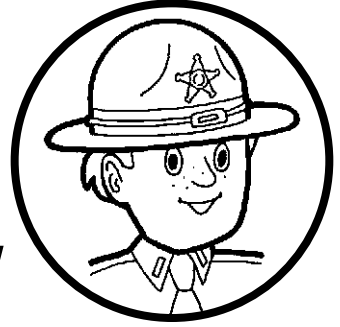


**“But if I start now, I’ll be ready

Remember **NO! GO! YELL! TELL!**



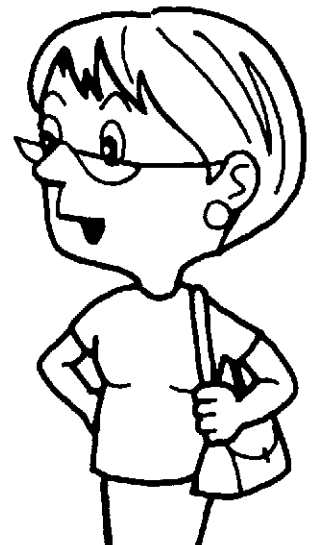
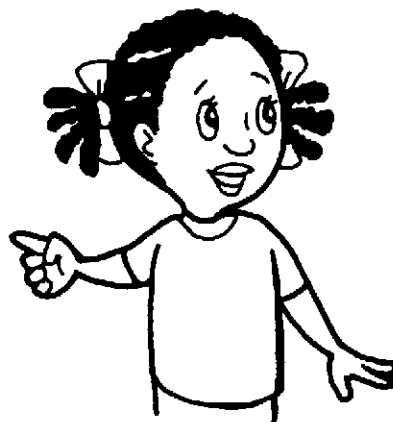
Never help a stranger who is grown up even if they say they have lost a puppy or a kitty. Say **NO!**
