Here are some things to do if someone ever bothers you or tries to touch you in a way that makes you feel icky. We all have what are called body boundaries. These places, covered by your bathing suit are your private parts.



No one should touch your private parts!

If someone touches you or your private parts, say NO!



Remember to YELL and TELL a grown-up that you trust!

If someone asks you to keep a secret about touching, say, "No, I'm going to tell!"



There are lots of different kinds of secrets. There are safe secrets and tell secrets. Surprise parties and gifts are safe secrets. Tell secrets are things that make you feel scared or uncomfortable. Tell them to an adult who will help you!

Your body belongs to YOU!



Nobody should touch your body without your permission.



Know the difference between safe touching, a hug from your mom or dad, and unsafe touching from a stranger.

It is OKAY to say NO to an adult if you are frightened or don't want to do something.





Let a trusted grown-up know if you have a problem, no matter how scary or embarrassing. They will listen, believe you and help you.


Trust yourself. If you feel that something is wrong or uncomfortable for you, remember


