But just like riding your bike or crossing the street, there are rules to keep you safe while you're on-line.

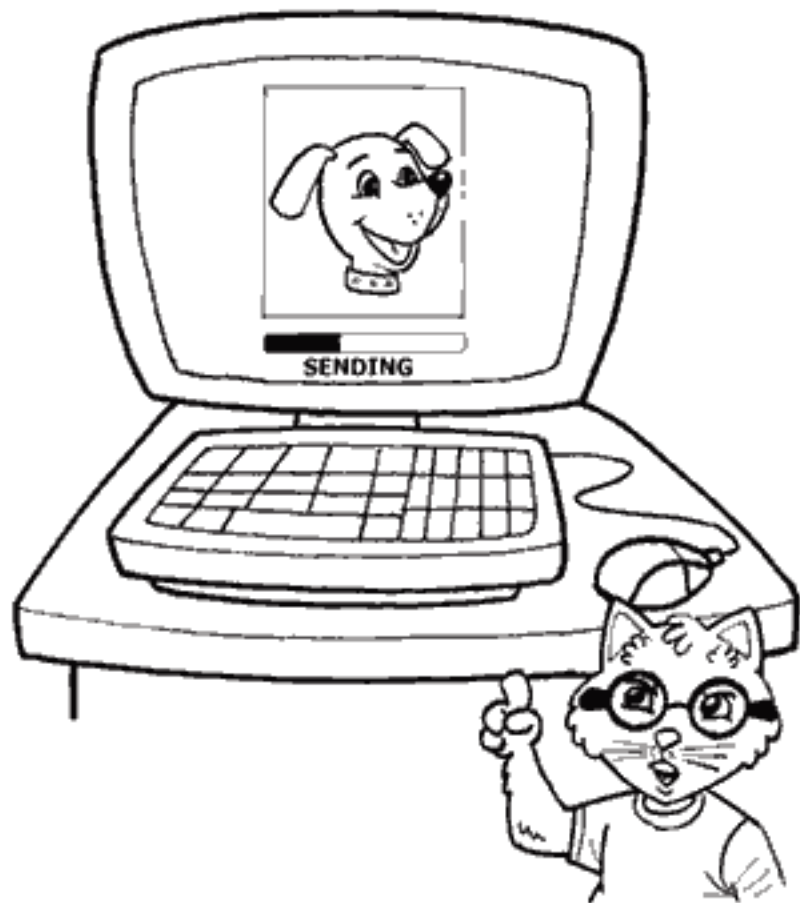


The Most Important Rule!

Never give out personal information about yourself.
This means your name, home address, the name of
your school and your telephone number.



Never send your picture without first checking with your parents or a grownup.





Never agree to get together with someone you "meet" on-line without first checking with a grownup. If they say it's okay, be sure to meet in a public place and bring a grownup along. Remember people on-line may not be who they say they are!

Always tell a grownup right away if you come across any information that makes you uncomfortable or scared!



Set Up On-line Rules!



1. The time of day that you can be on-line.
2. How long you can be on-line.
3. What sites you can visit.



Don't respond to any messages that are mean or make you feel uncomfortable.



Remember, it's not your fault if you get an icky message. Be sure to tell a grownup if it happens.

Never, ever give out your Internet password to anyone (even your best friends) except to your parents.



Ask permission before downloading or installing software or doing anything that could possibly hurt your computer or risk your family's privacy.

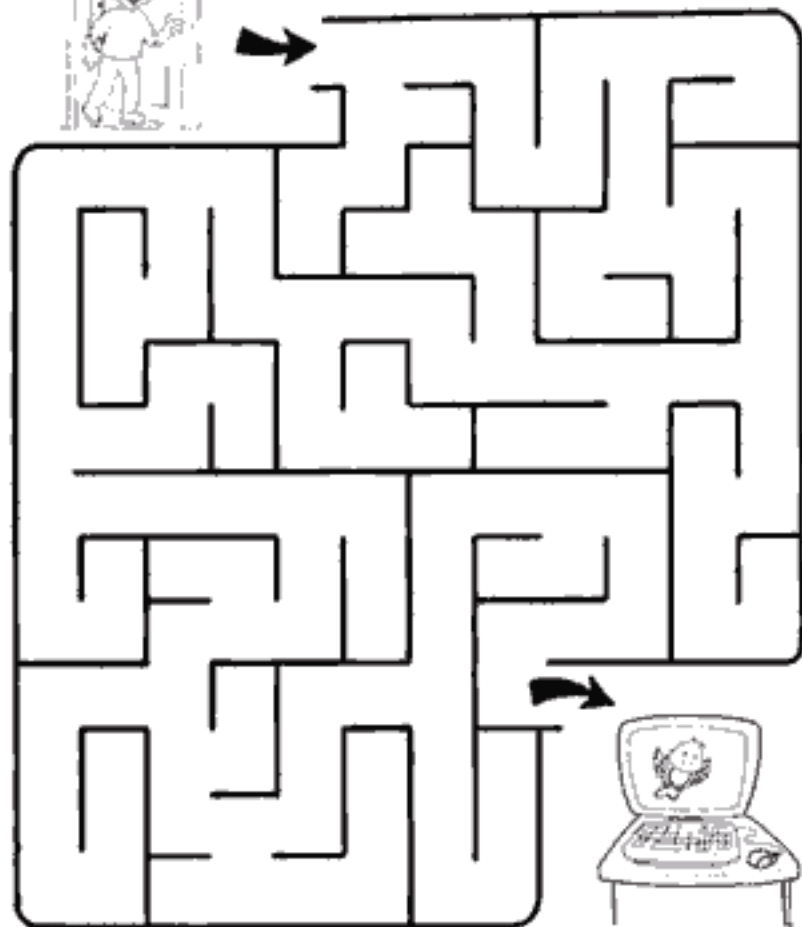
